

## THE NAME KUGANHA

Kuganha is a Shona word shaped by courage, choice and quiet certainty.

In Shona tradition, it describes a woman who, guided by conviction rather than convention, chooses the man she wishes to marry and walks to him – belongings in hand – to claim the future she has chosen. It is an act of self-assured devotion. Simple in form. Powerful in intent.

The name carries a clear energy. It is not loud. It does not need to explain itself. It speaks of knowing what matters and moving towards it with certainty.

At Kuganha, that same spirit defines the guest experience.

Set within the Karoo, Kuganha is a place where arrival becomes a conscious choice. A choice to step away from pace, pressure and performance. A choice to enter space. A choice to be private, unhurried and present.

Here, remoteness becomes clarity. Stillness replaces urgency. The day is shaped around the guest's own rhythm, not a fixed programme.

Nothing is forced. Nothing is performed.

Kuganha is bold love, expressed quietly. A love for space. For self. For intention. Like its name, the lodge stands assured in its truth – remote, intimate and considered – inviting those who arrive to choose stillness, and in doing so, choose themselves.

Kuganha means moving towards what you know to be true. Here, that truth is space, stillness and time to return to yourself.
