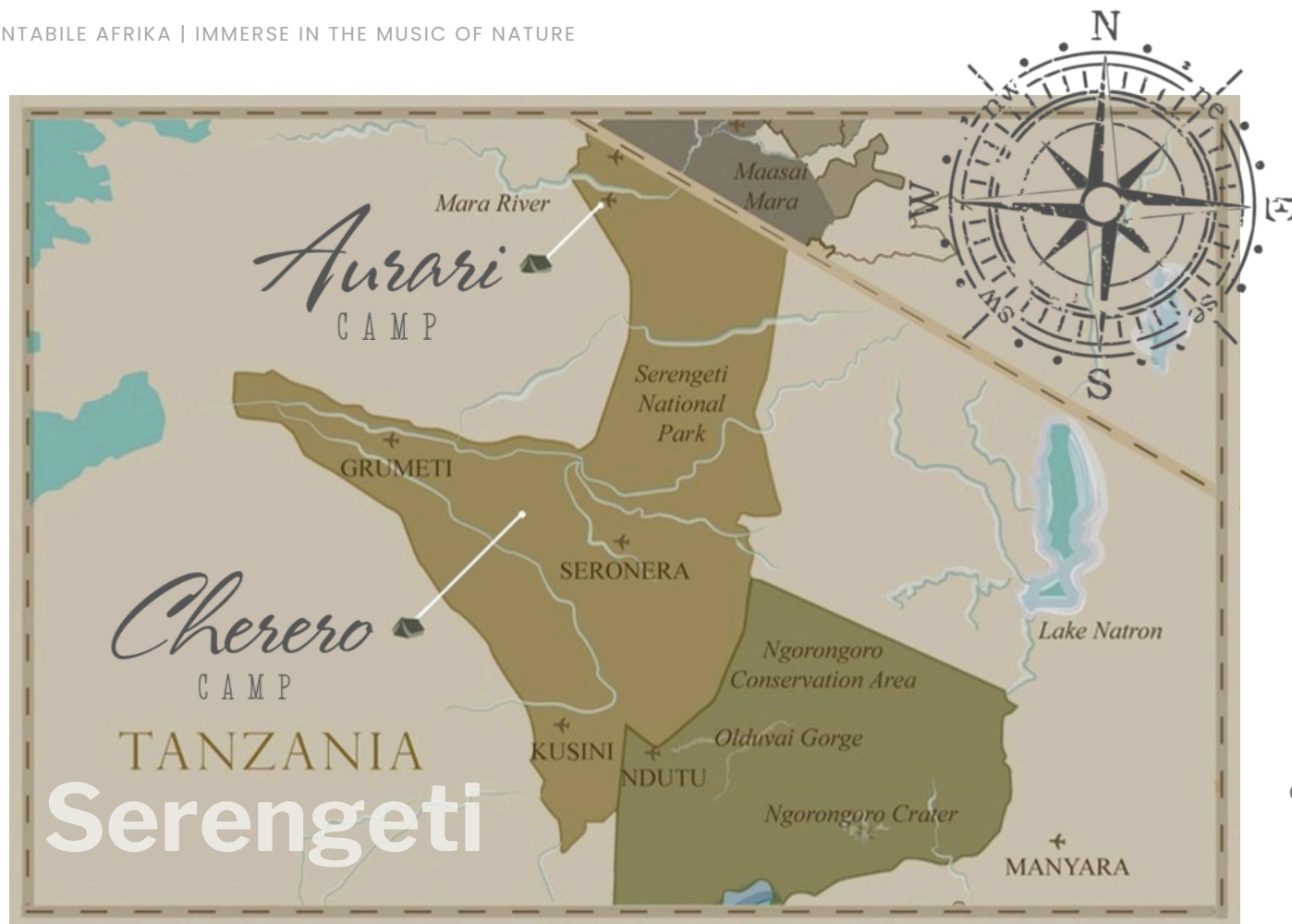

MINDFUL, conscious and values-aligned, AURARI CAMP and CHERERO CAMP are owner-run safari camps that feel like a different game. In an exotic land where giant corporations seek to set their footprints, the creators of Kantabile Afrika stayed true to their principles in crafting two eco-friendly sanctuaries in Serengeti National Park that are soulful and genuinely authentic. Tucked away on the slopes of Wogakuria hills a respectful distance away from the Mara River, Aurari Camp's location was carefully chosen to provide guests with access to witness the Great Migration spectacle while not contributing to the congestion that is prevalent during peak season. Aurari Camp stands out not because of striking features, but by virtue of its understated elegance.

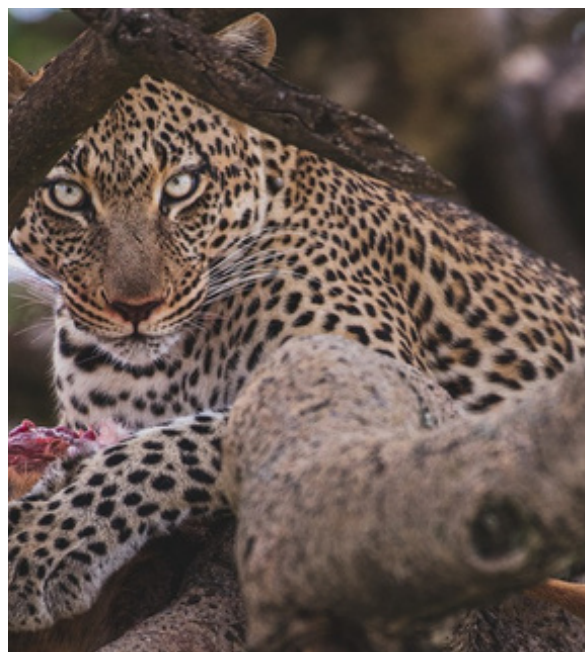
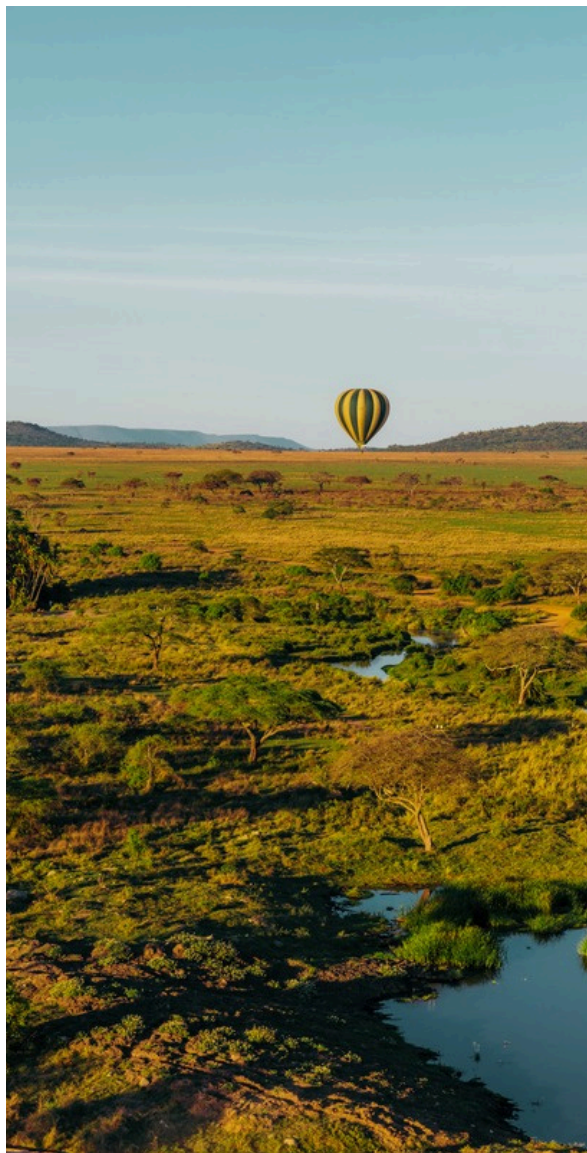
DAY 1

Your adventure begins the moment you touch down at Kogatende Airstrip. Greeted by your private guide with warm smiles, and light refreshments, you'll set off on a scenic game drive to camp. There's no rush, we will take it "poli poli" as the journey itself is part of the experience, with your first glimpses of wildlife and the golden plains welcoming you to the rhythm of the bush.

At Aurari Camp, our team awaits to welcome you with genuine Tanzanian hospitality and a hot lunch prepared by our in-house chefs. After settling into your spacious tented suite, enjoy a drink on your private veranda or stretch your legs with a short guided walk around camp.

In the late afternoon, head out on your first game drive when the soft golden light begins to bathe the landscape and wildlife activity picks up once more. Return to camp just in time for sunset, where a candlelit dinner under the stars awaits. Then retreat to your private suite (your own sanctuary in the wild) for a restful night serenaded by the sounds of the savannah.





DAY 2

This morning is all about options. For those seeking adventure, rise before dawn for a hot air balloon safari where you will eagerly await the moment when you will ascend above the golden Serengeti plains just as the sun breaks the horizon.

Spot herds of wildebeest, giraffes, and elephants from above. Upon landing, a celebratory champagne breakfast awaits in the bush, a once in a lifetime experience. The rest of the morning is a relaxed game drive back to camp, where you may even be welcomed by a different kind of visitor... It's not unusual for wildebeest to pass right by the tents, a front-row seat to the Migration, from the comfort of your own veranda.

Alternatively, enjoy a full-day game drive, exploring the wonders of the Northern Serengeti and beyond. With a hamper lunch packed, you venture to lesser-travelled corners, far from the usual crowds. In these remote stretches, black rhinos are carefully monitored by rangers, offering a rare chance to spot one of Africa's most endangered icons.

Return to camp at dusk, where a warm meal awaits. Enjoy a final nightcap and a little stargazing by the fire before retreating to bed, lulled by the distant calls of lions.

DAY 3

As the first light kisses the horizon, begin your day with a private sunrise breakfast, made to order and served with front-row seats to nature's most spectacular show.

Today, we head out for a full-day game drive towards the famed Mara River, where you may have the extraordinary chance to witness part of the Great Wildebeest Migration as herds navigate crocodile-infested waters. With a packed hamper in hand, the day unfolds at nature's pace. Patient observation often rewards guests with unforgettable scenes of tension, triumph, and survival.

For those seeking deeper cultural immersion, we offer an optional private visit to the Kuria Tribe in the Tarime District, located just outside Serengeti National Park. This rare opportunity, available by advance arrangement, offers insight into local customs, crafts, and traditions that shape daily life in the region.

Return to camp at dusk, where a warm meal and a peaceful night under the stars await.

Tomorrow, another adventure in the wild begins.





DAY 4

Another adventure-filled day awaits. Venture further afield to explore the untamed corners of the Northern Serengeti, perhaps tracking resident wildlife through the remote Lamai Triangle or the quiet beauty of Bologonja, nestled near the Kenyan border. These areas are known for their solitude and excellent game-viewing opportunities, far from the typical safari crowds.

As golden hour approaches, raise a toast with a private sundowner atop Simba Kopje, a giant granite boulder offering panoramic views and a sense of timeless stillness (advance booking required).

The day closes with a celebration dinner, crafted with care and served under the Serengeti sky. A fitting finale to your last night at Aurari Camp.

DAY 5

There's no need to set an alarm today. Sleep in, cocooned in the comfort of your tented suite, as the sounds of nature gently filter through the canvas. Birdsong, rustling leaves, the distant call of wildlife welcoming the morning.

When you're ready, savour a slow breakfast in the open-air dining area. Whether it's fresh fruit, a full English, pancakes or just a perfectly brewed cup of coffee, this is your moment to reflect.

Soon, it's time to bid farewell to the Serengeti, though we never truly say goodbye, only "see you later". Your guide will accompany you on the journey back to the airstrip, taking the scenic route so you can soak in the last sights of the plains, perhaps catching a final glimpse of zebra herds or a lingering lion in the grass.

As you take off, look down one last time as the Serengeti stretches endlessly beneath you, natural, wild, and unforgettable.
